9 **A Funding Bill to Provide Solar Lighting to Campus Bus Shelters**

11 Whereas, The University of Arkansas currently has 14 covered bus
12 shelters around campus, while only 3 have LED solar
13 powered lighting.

14
15 Whereas, Each LED solar panel lighting kit costs \$1,500.00 and
16 includes lighting, solar panels, and a battery pack that is
17 retrofitted to accommodate all shelters.

18
19 Whereas, The City of Fayetteville funded the 3 shelters that currently
20 have the solar panel lighting kits, which have received
21 positive feedback from the community.

22
23 Be it therefore resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
24 supports the funding and implementation of
25 LED solar panel lighting kits in sheltered bus
26 stops to further promote student safety.

27
28 Be it further resolved: The LED solar panel lighting kits will be
29 distributed to sheltered bus stops including;
30 Hotz (2), Meadow (2), Lot 99 (3), Reid (1), Lot
31 44 (2), Adohi (1).

33 Be it further resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
34 should allocate \$16,500 from the Registered
35 Student Organization Allocations Budget for
36 the purchase of 11 LED solar panel lighting kits.

37
38 Be it further resolved: All excess funds will be reallocated back to the
39 Registered Student Organization Allocations
40 Budget.

42 Be it finally resolved: A copy of this bill be sent to Director of
43 Razorback Transit Adam Waddell and Director
44 of Parking and Transit Gary Smith.
