Andy Brayman will give a lecture in which he discusses aspects of his working process that deal with emerging ceramic technologies, such as 3D printing and CNC milling—an aspect of ceramics that is in need of further elaboration within our program and that the RSO has great interest in. He will also talk about his production process, and how he has incorporated light industrial processes into his ceramics and pottery practice, such as ram presses, filter presses, unique casting methods, and decal production. His practice represents a model of the working studio ceramist that is unique from the education currently being provided within our classes, and that all members of the RSO would benefit tremendously from learning about. This lecture will be a way for the community to gain access to a new way of thinking. Brayman is a leader in the field and will bring his unique experience to the University of Arkansas community.

At their best, his pots demonstrate an object's potential to be both beautiful and cerebral. He's showed work across the United States, including Colorado, Washington, and New York. In 2005, Andy founded The Matter Factory in Kansas City. It is part artist studio, part laboratory, and part factory. In addition to producing objects of his design, Brayman researches and builds computationally controlled machines for use in art making.

This includes but is not limited to newswire stories, creating and submitting advertisement/promotional materials, and answering any questions the staff may have. If the amount approved is greater than the amount requested it is because the board added taxes to it.
