11 **A Bill to Support the Celebration of the National Random Acts of**

14 Whereas, The Associated Student Government has 50 senators
15 representing over 27,000 students at the University of
16 Arkansas and encourages these students to voice their
17 concerns regarding campus life, academic development, and
18 personal growth; and

20 Whereas, The ASG mission statement is as follows: The purpose of the
21 Associated Student Government is to act as an organized
22 voice for all undergraduate students of the University of
23 Arkansas, to effectively represent undergraduate students in
24 the University's decision and policy making process, and to
25 provide a broad education experience for undergraduate
26 students while promoting citizenship on campus and in the
27 greater community; and

29 Whereas Promoting the practice of positive values is the best way to
30 ensure a healthy society and, therefore, a responsibility that
31 the Associated Student Government has as part of their
32 mission to empower young people to become good citizens
33 who understand that the progress of a nation starts by
