Human trafficking has gained widespread notoriety in recent years. Despite this, labor trafficking and forced labor continue unabated, unnoticed, and misunderstood. This symposium will introduce attendees to the nature and scale of labor trafficking in the U.S., explore the impacts of this form of labor abuse, and offer legal and other strategies for address it.

The speakers who have agreed to present at this event are leaders in their fields and students will greatly benefit in hearing from them.

Martina Vandenberg is the founder and president of the Human Trafficking Pro Bono Legal Center. She has spent two decades fighting human trafficking, forced labor, rape as a war crime, and violence against women. Ms. Vandenberg has testified before the Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on Human Rights and the Law, the Helsinki Commission, the House Foreign Affairs Committee, and the House Armed Services Committee on an array of human rights issues. Through HT Pro Bono, Vandenberg has trained more than 2,000 pro bono attorneys nationwide to handle human trafficking matters.

Ms. Vandenburg will open the symposium by describing the scale of human trafficking as a whole, the common types and methods of human trafficking, and the laws regulating human trafficking. Her talk will have an opportunity for Q and A at the end.

CAST (Coalition to Abolish Slavery and Trafficking) is the nation's largest provider of comprehensive services to survivors of human trafficking and is an advocate for groundbreaking policies and legislation. Among other services, CAST connects survivors of sex and labor trafficking with organizations wanting to know more about the personal experiences of trafficking survivors and how they can help.

A human trafficking survivor will come and share their personal experience of human trafficking and will teach viewers how they can identify human trafficking and what they should do when they see it.

Kristi Graunke is an attorney with the Southern Poverty Law Center. Her legal work focuses on the enforcement of the civil rights of low-wage workers. Before joining the SPLC in 2005, she was a clerk for U.S. Circuit Judge Marsha S. Berzon of the Ninth Circuit. She was also an Equal Justice Works law fellow with the Farmworker Division of Georgia Legal Services in Atlanta.

The session will inform students about the areas of agriculture where trafficking is an issue, how trafficking is carried out in these areas, and what can be done to combat trafficking in the agricultural context.
