After graduation, two years in the Army, and a more objective look at my abilities and interests, Professor Philpot returned to school with a different perspective and altered goals, obtaining a B.S. degree in Physics from the State University of New York at Stony Brook. Continuing on to graduate school in oceanography, specializing in ocean optics and remote sensing, Dr. Philpot obtained M.S. (1987) and Ph.D. degrees (1981) in Marine Studies at the University of Delaware. Upon graduation Professor Philpot was delighted to join the faculty of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Cornell University, where Dr. Philpot has conducted research in remote sensing that has involved a broad range of applications of remote sensing - from ocean optics to vegetation monitoring to beach trafficability. Sabbatical leaves in academia (RIT, University of Southern Mississippi), industry (WRI) and government (NASA, Naval Research Laboratory) have empowered a broad perspective and knowledge base in remote sensing and radiative transfer while broadening my contact base. Dr. Philpot continues to conduct research in a variety of aspects of remote sensing and teaches courses in Remote Sensing and Digital Image Processing.
