10 **A Funding Bill to Purchase Additional Scantrons for Student Use**

12 Whereas, the Associated Student Government has previously supplied
13 students with Scantrons at no cost from the ASG Office, and

14
15 Whereas, The supply of Scantrons the ASG Senate allocated with
16 \$571.98 amount last semester are now in low stock or
17 completely out, and

18
19 Whereas, Scantrons may only be purchased at Club Red or from select
20 vending machines across campus, and

21
22 Whereas, the vending machines are not consistently stocked and
23 frequently out of order, thus an unreliable source for
24 students to purchase Scantrons.

26 Be it therefore resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
27 allocate \$376.42 from the Senate Legislative
28 Allocations Budget (LS-Prog) for the purchase
29 of 250 Blue 4521 Scantrons, 250 Green 882-E
30 Scantrons, 500 Datalink Scantrons, and 100
31 Blue Books to be kept in the ASG Office and
32 made available for student use.

33
34 Be it further resolved: Further legislation may be brought to the floor
35 to fund additional Scantron purchases as
36 necessary.

38 Be it further resolved: All excess funds will be reallocated back to the
39 Senate Allocations Budget (LS-Prog).




