10 **A Resolution Supporting the Implementation of Informational**
11 **Sexual/Relationship Violence Stickers in Restroom Stalls of New and**
12 **Newly Renovated Campus Buildings**

14 Whereas, The “Campus Climate Survey” conducted by the Title IX Office
15 in 2017 - as a continued effort to prevent sexual assault on our
16 campus and designed to gauge student attitudes and
17 experiences - revealed that a significant percentage of
18 students were not aware of how to report sexual assault or
19 misconduct when presented with such a situation; and

20

21 Whereas, Over 2,800 students participated in the Climate Survey, and
22 28.4% of these students did not know about the availability of
23 on-campus resources related to sexual violence¹; and

24

25 Whereas, As a result of said statistics, an ad hoc committee constituted
26 by representatives from the Pat Walker Health Center, Title
27 IX office, Housing Office, University Relations, and Student
28 Affairs endorsed and approved the plan to design and

29 implement sexual/relationship violence stickers in restrooms
30 of *most* campus buildings²; and

31

32 Whereas, A rapidly growing flagship institution, the University of
33 Arkansas has recently opened two fully renovated floors in
34 Mullins Library as well as the new Student Success Center,
35 gathering students, faculty, and staff from most - if not all -
36 demographic sectors of campus, *none of which* have installed
37 sexual/relationship violence stickers in restroom stalls; and

39 Whereas, The addition of these stickers would positively affect individuals
40 from all areas of campus by having readily available access to this
41 information; then

42

43 Be it therefore resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
44 supports the *Implementation of Informational*
45 *Sexual/Relationship Violence Stickers in*
46 *Restroom Stalls of New and Newly Renovated*
47 *Campus Buildings* in an effort to prevent sexual
48 assault on our campus; and

50 Be it further resolved: The printing of new stickers is to be funded by the
51 Dean of Students Office and installed in new
52 locations by Facilities Management, and the
53 Creative Services Department is to be contacted to
54 obtain a template for the sticker design found in
55 other restroom locations; and

57 Be it finally resolved: A copy of this legislation be sent to Interim Vice
58 Chancellor for Student Affairs Melissa Harwood-
59 Rom, Associate Dean of Students Lori Lander,




