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8 **A Resolution to Add “Made Without Gluten” Labels on the Dine on**
9 **Campus App**

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11 Whereas, Gluten-free students at the University of Arkansas have
12 limited access to dining on campus due to the lack of gluten-
13 sensitive labeled food options; and

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15 Whereas, An estimated 7% of the population must eat gluten free for
16 various medical conditions, including Celiac Disease, gluten
17 sensitivity, and wheat allergies; and

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19 Whereas , The effects of a student being exposed to gluten through
20 unlabeled foods on campus can be detrimental to their
21 health, including gastrointestinal symptoms, intestinal lining
22 damage, anemia, brain fog, and fatigue; and

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24 Whereas, The University of Georgia and the University of North
25 Carolina both have implemented a “free of gluten or made
26 without gluten” label on their online dining menus; and

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28 Whereas, Auburn University opened the nation’s first ever gluten-free
29 dedicated dining hall.

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31 Be it therefore resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
32 supports the addition of “made without gluten”
33 symbols to the Dine on Campus app like that of
34 the University of North Carolina.
