8 **A Resolution in Support of Inclusive T-Shirt Sizing**

10 Whereas, Petite and plus-size students often struggle to find free t-
11 shirts on campus in their size, and

13 Whereas, Numerous studies conclude that body image issues and
14 clinical disorders relating to dissatisfaction with one's
15 physical body are more prevalent among college students,
16 and

18 Whereas, Providing students of all body shapes and sizes the
19 opportunity to find free shirts in their size promotes feelings
20 of inclusion and belonging which benefits overall student
21 success;

23 Be it therefore resolved: ASG Senate recognizes the importance that
24 size-inclusivity plays in belonging on campus
25 and feelings of acceptance.

27 Be it further resolved: The Associated Student Government Senate
28 supports messaging from university leadership
29 that encourages RSOs and University offices to
30 include sizing from extra-small to 4XL when
31 they hand out free t-shirts.

35 Academic Deans and the Vice Chancellor for
36 Student Affairs.


